**Meeting Minutes  
State College Borough Tree Commission  
January 15, 2020**

The Borough's Tree Commission (TRC) met on Wednesday, January 15, 2020, in the Administrative Conference Room of the Service Facility, located at 330 South Osmond Street. Mr. Sam called the meeting to order at 12:26 p.m.

**Welcome and Introductions**

Mr. Sam welcomed everyone to the reorganizational meeting and introduced Ms. Dauler to all who were present.

**Election of Chair and Vice Chair**

Mr. Sam asked for nominations for Chair. Mr. Rohrbach nominated Mr. Herman and Ms. Dauler seconded. All were in favor, and Mr. Herman accepted the position of Chair. Mr. Herman asked for nominations for Vice Chair. Mr. Rohrbach nominated Ms. Schuckers and Ms. Dauler seconded the motion. All were in favor and Ms. Schuckers was elected Vice Chair.

Mr. Herman welcomed Ms. Dauler to the Commission and then invited each member to inform Ms. Dauler of their roll within the Borough.

**Public Hour**

No comments were heard during the Public Hour.

**Approval of Minutes**

On a motion by Mr. Rohrbach and seconded Ms. Dauler, the November 20, 2019 meeting minutes were approved as submitted. The vote was unanimously in favor.

## **Action Items**

### Request to Remove Street Trees at the Following Addresses

1. 132S. Patterson Street – 34” Norway Maple – Request by West Penn Power. Decay 8’ & 12’ up
2. 1001 Metz Avenue – 30” Norway Maple. Request by West Penn Power. Decay on sidewalk side near branch union. The owner said he was okay with removal, but wanted another tree removed as well, but we will look at it at the drive arounds.
3. 667 Franklin Street – 20” Sugar Maple – Request by property owner. Large hanger, deadwood

Mr. Sam said the trees in #1 and #2 both had decay but were not an immediate hazard. He added it would be acceptable to have them removed at this time and Mr. Rohrbach supported having West Penn Power take care of the removals.

Ms. Dauler made a motion to have the 34” Norway Maple at 132 S. Patterson Street and the 30” Norway Maple at 1001 Metz Avenue taken down by West Penn Power. Mr. Rohrbach seconded the motion, and all were in favor. This motion would be recommended to the Public Works Director.

Mr. Sam noted he had a discussion with the property owner at 667 Franklin Street who said she was agreeable with keeping the tree for now but was concerned with what the replacement tree would be. He pointed out there was definitely room for a replacement. Mr. Rohrbach commented he thought the tree was unsightly and did not feel money should be wasted in pruning it. Mr. Herman responded saying the tree had a lot of life left in it and should be pruned. He suggested the tree be looked at this summer after pruning.

Ms. Dauler made a motion that, at the request of the property owner, the tree be pruned and looked at again by the Commission at the summer drive arounds. Mr. Rohrbach seconded the motion, and all were in favor. This motion would be recommended to the Public Works Director.

## **Other Matters**

### 2020 Meeting Schedule

Mr. Sam affirmed the Commission already approved the 2020 meeting schedule, and all meetings would start at the State College Borough Service Facility except for the two September public hearings. He said the public hearings would be held in the Municipal Building.

Mr. Sam said he would look at changing meetings to 12:30 p.m. to accommodate Ms. Dauler’s Wednesday teaching schedule. If that could not be done, Ms. Dauler said she would adjust her schedule on those days.

## **Items of Information**

### 2020 Work Plan

The members reviewed the 2020 Tree Commission Work Plan as presented to Council by Mr. Herman. Mr. Sam called attention to #3 “Work Collaboratively with Adjacent Tree Commissions” stating he did not know of any other entities to have joint meetings with but would check with Mr. Elmendorf. Regarding #5 “Review Web Page” Mr. Sam said he planned to invite Mr. Douglas Shontz, Communications Coordinator, to the March meeting to review the updated Borough website with the Members. Mr. Sam said regarding #6 “Complete new Tree Bike Ride Brochure” he and Ms. Fields were working on that and would discuss it with Mr. Elmendorf. Mr. Sam noted #7 “Review Recommended Planting List” would be discussed at the March meeting. He added the list was started last year and the Commission would discuss how it could be revised. Lastly, Mr. Sam discussed #8 “Review Policy for Right-of-Way Plantings in the Downtown District” stating he would be meeting with the Borough Engineer to specify the responsibility of staff and property owners.

Mr. Herman shared a typed copy of his comments made to Council in his presentation and handed a copy to Ms. Hall to be made a part of the record.

### 2020 Conflict of Interest Statement

Mr. Sam explained the 2020 Conflict of Interest Statement, along with a memo from Mr. Ed LeClear, explaining the purpose of the statement were attached to the agenda for review. Ms. Hoag pointed out everyone who served as volunteers on an ABC needed to be supplied with a HUD Conflict of Interest Policy which would become a part of the meeting minutes. Mr. Herman advised the members to take it upon themselves to read and understand the policy.

## **Reports of Interest**

### Arborist's Report

Mr. Sam reported on recent activities. Highlights included:

- The Tree Crew continued to work on removals and currently had seven street trees left to remove along with some park trees. Mr. Sam commented the current crew was one of the best crews he had ever worked with.
- A third Dendritian was approved in the 2020 Budget.
- A new bucket truck with a 70-foot working height was ordered and should be delivered this summer.
- An assistant sustainability staff member had been approved in the 2020 Budget.
- Hired contractor, Dincher and Dincher to prune the west side of College Heights. The work should be completed by the end of February. Mr. Sam said this was part of the 2019 Tree Trimming Project. He added that the pruning project for 2020 would likely be Homes-Foster Park.
- Upcoming landscaping projects included the West Fairmount Island and the Beaver Garage.
- Ash trees continue to be injected with insecticide to control Emerald Ash Borer. He noted the Borough was one of only 11 communities to write an Ash Management Plan and send to the Bureau of Forestry which allowed us to apply for grant funds. Ms. Dauler asked if we would eventually lose all Ash trees and Mr. Sam answered yes, but we were trying to make them last as long as possible.
- Ms. Fields continued to work on a tree inventory as well as exploring new inventory programs. She will be attending a webinar training to see what could be implemented within the Borough. Other projects she is working on includes Arbor Day on April 24<sup>th</sup> and the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Earth Day to be held the same week.
- Mr. Sam said he was moving forward with the East Fairmount Park Plan with Ms. Safko and Mr. Sassaman.
- Regarding the Action Sports Park, Mr. Sam said staff would apply for a grant to help fund it. He added he planned to apply for a design grant this year followed by a construction grant next year.
- A list was being put together to get a quote for new trees and in March Mr. Sam would go to nurseries to tag the trees. Ms. Fields said more trees would be planted in Walnut Springs Park in the spring and she would continue to work with the Clear Water Conservatory.
- A property owner on the 300 block of Ridge Avenue would like to put in a rain garden.

## **Adjournment**

There being no further business to discuss, Mr. Rohrbach made motion to adjourn the meeting at 1:12 p.m. Mr. Dauler seconded the motion, and all were in favor.
