

# Proclamation


*IN CELEBRATION OF THE

- WHEREAS, the Centre County 4-H Robotics Club (CC4H) is a local STEM organization focused on education, teamwork and innovation and aimed at exposing a diverse group of kids to real world engineering challenges at an early age; and
- WHEREAS, those who have participated in the CC4H program have reporting increased confidence and leadership skills in addition to the technical skills and real world experience they gained from the hands on work; and
- WHEREAS, FIRST (For Inspiration and Recognition of Science and Technology) was founded in 1989 and hosts the highly competitive FIRST Robotics Competition (FRC) each year, which requires building a large robot using professional grade components and controlling it over WIFI; and
- WHEREAS, in 2012 CC4H was selected to put together a team for the FRC, and in its first year of competition earned a "highest rookie seed" award. Each year since a dedicated team of students, mentors and community sponsors have strived to improve the performance at each competition; and
- WHEREAS, after winning the Regional competition, the CC4H team advanced to the World Championship, competing as one of 405 teams from 22 states and seven countries and winning their first World Championship as part of a 4-team alliance.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mayor Donald Hahn, do hereby, on behalf of the Borough of State College, offer **CONGRATULATIONS** to the team and encourage all residents to acknowledge this achievement and support the Centre County 4-H Robotics Club in their endeavors.
