

Recycling A to Z

Here is a list of items that are either collected with your weekly collection or should be disposed of in another way.

Color Key

Green – place in your green-lid organics cart for composting

Black – place in your black-lid waste cart for waste to be transported to a municipal solid waste landfill

Brown – request bulk pickup for large refuse items or large brush

Blue – recyclable in residential or commercial CCRRA recycling container

Purple – recyclable at drop-off locations or through other recycling programs

Red - bring to the Household Hazardous Waste Event at CCRRA

A

- **abrasive cleaners** – bring to the CCRRA Annual Hazardous Waste Collection Event
- **acetone** – bring to the CCRRA Annual Hazardous Waste Collection Event
- **aerosol sprays** – bring to the CCRRA Annual Hazardous Waste Collection Event
- **air filters** – black-lid waste cart
- **air freshener** – black-lid waste cart
- **alkaline batteries** (non-rechargeable) – black-lid waste cart
- **all-purpose cleaners** – bring to the CCRRA Annual Hazardous Waste Collection Event
- **aluminum cans and lids, rinsed (beverage, soup, vegetable etc.)** – CCRRA recycling container
- **aluminum containers, rinsed (pie plates, take out containers, etc.)** – CCRRA recycling container
- **aluminum foil**, rinsed – CCRRA recycling container
- **antifreeze** – see “Special Materials Recycling Locations”
- **appliances (fridges, stoves, dishwashers, microwaves, washer/dryer, etc.)** – If in good condition, [freecycle](#); or, request bulk-item pickup. All appliances are recyclable by drop-off at CCRRA
- **appliances, still running (fridges, freezers and room air conditioners only)** – [contact First Energy to turn in old appliance for cash \(some requirements apply, only refrigerators, freezers and room air conditioners\)](#);
- **ashes, cooled (from a wood burning fire)** – green-lid organics cart
- **ashes, cooled (from coal burning fire)** – black-lid waste cart
- **automotive waste** – see “Special Materials Recycling Locations”
- **bake ware, single use (aluminum)** – CCRRA recycling container
- **balloons** – deposit in local grocery store’s plastic bag recycling bin
- **batteries, non-rechargeable** – black-lid waste cart
- **batteries, NiCad and rechargeable** – “Special Materials Recycling Locations”
- **batteries, automotive** – see “Special Materials Recycling Locations”
- **beef and beef remains** – green-lid organics cart
- **birth control and contraceptive products** – Contact your pharmacy or bring to the Annual Prescription Take Back Event through the Borough Police Department
- **biosolids** – University Area Joint Authority
- **bleach** – bring to the CCRRA Annual Hazardous Waste Collection Event
- **blueprints** – black-lid waste cart
- **bones** (chicken, beef, pork, etc.) – green-lid organics cart (recommended to wrap in newspaper)

B

- **baby bottle liners, rinsed** – deposit in local grocery store’s plastic bag recycling bin
- **bake ware, not reusable (muffin tins, cookie sheets etc.)** – see “metal scrap”

B

- **books (paperbacks)** – CCRRA recycling container (No hardback books unless covers are removed)
- **bottle caps (metal or plastic)** – CCRRA recycling container
- **Bounce sheets** – black-lid waste cart
- **bows and ribbons** – black-lid waste cart
- **box or paperboard** (cereal, cracker, Kleenex boxes etc.) – CCRRA recycling container
- **branches (<2" diameter)** – green-lid organics cart (cut to size)
- **branches (>2" diameter)** – request bulk pick up
- **bread bags, clean** – deposit in local grocery store's plastic bag recycling bin
- **bread, baked goods** – green-lid organics cart
- **bricks** – black-lid waste cart, request bulk pickup (fees may be assessed for collection of construction materials), or take to Glenn O. Hawbaker Recycling Center
- **broken glass** (wrapped in paper) – black-lid waste cart
- **brush** – green-lid organics cart or, if in large quantities, request bulk pickup
- **bubble wrap** – deposit in local grocery store's plastic bag recycling bin or at UPS stores
- **butane** – bring to the CCRRA Annual Hazardous Waste Collection Event
- **buckets** – black-lid waste cart

C

- **candles** – black-lid waste cart
- **candy** – green-lid organics cart
- **car batteries** – see "Special Materials Recycling Locations"
- **carbon paper** – black-lid waste cart
- **cardboard (waxed, oily, wet or soiled, remove all plastic)** – green-lid organics cart
- **cardboard (small, flattened)** – Place underneath the CCRRA recycling container or visit www.centrecountyrecycles.org for drop-off locations
- **carpet (must fit inside cart)** – black-lid waste cart
- **cassette tapes** – black-lid waste cart
- **cat food bags** – black-lid waste cart
- **cat litter** – black-lid waste cart
- **catalogues and newspaper inserts** – CCRRA recycling container
- **caulking tubes** – black-lid waste cart
- **CDs and DVDs** – deposit at Best Buy
- **cell phones and accessories** – see "Special Materials Recycling Locations"
- **ceramics and dishes** – black-lid waste cart
- **ceramic plant pots** – black-lid waste cart or reuse in the bottom of planting pots for better drainage
- **cereal** – green-lid organics cart
- **cereal and other food boxes (flattened)** – CCRRA recycling container

- **cereal plastic liner** – deposit in local grocery store's plastic bag recycling bin
- **cheeses** – green-lid organics cart
- **cheese slice wrapper** (cleaned) – deposit in local grocery store's plastic bag recycling bin
- **chicken and chicken remains** - green-lid organics cart (recommended to wrap in newspaper)
- **cigarettes and ashes, bagged** – black-lid waste cart
- **cigarette lighter (empty)** – black-lid waste cart
- **clay pots** – black-lid waste cart
- **cleaning wipes** – black-lid waste cart
- **clothing (not reusable)** – black-lid waste cart
- **coat hangers, metal or wire** – see "metal, scrap"
- **coat hangers, plastic** – donate or black-lid waste cart
- **coffee cups, paper (rinsed)** – green-lid organics cart
- **coffee filters, grounds** – green-lid organics cart
- **compostable bags** – green-lid organics cart
- **construction waste, reusable** – donate to organizations such as Habitat for Humanity Restore
- **construction waste, recyclable** – call for bulk pickup (fee may be assessed) or take to Glenn O. Hawbaker Recycling Center
- **cooking oil (cooled)** – green-lid organics cart
- **colored paper** – CCRRA recycling container
- **compact fluorescent light bulbs (CFLs)** – see "Special Materials Recycling Locations"

- **drink cups, plastic** – CCRRA miscellaneous plastics recycling drop off container
- **drink cups, plastic labeled “compostable”** – green-lid organics cart or black-lid waste cart, do not recycle
- **dry cleaning bags** – deposit in local grocery store’s plastic bag recycling bin
- **dryer lint** – black-lid waste cart
- **dryer sheets** – black-lid waste cart
- **drywall** – black-lid waste cart (must fit inside cart) or **request bulk pickup (may be assessed a fee)**
- **duct tape** - black-lid waste cart
- **DVDs** – Best Buy

- **eggs and egg shells** – green-lid organics cart
- **egg cartons, paper** – green-lid organics cart
- **egg cartons, plastic** – black-lid waste cart
- **elastic bands** – black-lid waste cart
- **electronics (CRT TVs, game consoles, audio equipment, etc.)** – see “Special Materials Recycling Locations”

- **envelopes (with or without plastic windows)** – CCRRA recycling container

- **facial tissue (no chemicals)** – green-lid organics cart
- **fast food waxed paper containers, no plastic coated containers** – green-lid organics cart

- **feminine hygiene items** – black-lid waste cart
- **film negatives** – black-lid waste cart
- **filters (e.g. Brita water filter)** – black-lid waste cart
- **fish and fish remains** – green-lid organics cart (recommended to wrap in newspaper)
- **floor sweepings, organic** – green-lid organics cart
- **flour, grains, dough** – green-lid organics cart
- **flour bags** – black-lid waste cart
- **flower pots, plastic (rinsed)** – CCRRA miscellaneous plastics recycling drop off container

- **medicine (pills, liquid)** – contact your pharmacy or bring to the Annual Prescription Take Back Event through the Borough Police Department
- **medicine bottles, plastic (rinsed)** – CCRRA recycling container
- **mercury thermometers** – take to the CCRRA office
- **metal lids from food jars (rinsed)** – CCRRA recycling container
- **metal rods, coat hangers, etc.** – see “metal, scrap”
- **metal, scrap** – drop off at the CCRRA Transfer Station free of charge
- **microwaves** – request bulk pickup or drop off at the CCRRA Transfer Station free of charge
- **milk cartons, paperboard (these are plastic coated)** – black-lid waste cart
- **milk jugs, plastic (rinsed)** – CCRRA recycling container
- **mussel shells or other shellfish** – green-lid organics cart (recommended to wrap in newspaper)

- **plastics (openings larger than girth of container, e.g. injection molded)** – CCRRA miscellaneous plastics recycling drop off container
- **plastics (soiled, not rinsable)** – black-lid waste cart
- **plexi-glass** – black-lid waste cart

- **seafood and shellfish** – green-lid organics cart (recommended to wrap in newspaper)

- **shampoo bottles (rinsed)** – CCRRA recycling container
- **sharps (razor blades, broken glass wrapped in paper)** – wrap in newspaper, tape and deposit in black-lid waste cart
- **shoe boxes, paper** – CCRRA recycling container

- **shredded paper** – green-lid organics cart

- **soap** – black-lid waste cart

- **soil** (very small amounts) – green-lid organics cart
- **solvents, turpentine, varnish, lacquers** – bring to the CCRRA Annual Hazardous Waste Collection Event
- **SOS pads** – black-lid waste cart
- **soup/vegetable cans, rinsed** - CCRRA recycling container
- **static cling cloths** – black-lid waste cart
- **steel wool** – black-lid waste cart

- **take out containers, aluminum (rinsed)** – CCRRA recycling container
- **take out containers, plastic (rinsed)** – CCRRA miscellaneous plastics recycling drop off container
- **take out containers, waxed paper cups, paperboard, pizza boxes (preferably labeled compostable)** – green-lid organics cart
- **take out containers, plastic coated** – black-lid waste cart
- **tape** – black-lid waste cart
- **tea bags** – green-lid organics cart
- **televisions** – request bulk pick up or drop off at Transfer Station free of charge

- **utensils, plastic** – CCRRA miscellaneous plastics recycling drop off container
- **utensils (biodegradable, corn plastic)** – black-lid waste cart; these items do not degrade well in our compost system and should not be recycled
- **utensils (metal)** – see “scrap metal”

V

- **vacuum bags** – black-lid waste cart
- **vegetables and peelings** – green-lid organics cart
- **video cassettes, VCR tapes** – black-lid waste cart
- **vinyl blinds** – black-lid waste cart
- **vitamins** – black-lid waste cart

W

- **wading pool, plastic**, without a recycle symbol (kids) – black-lid waste cart (lid must close) or request bulk pick up

- **walnut leaves or shells** – if possible to remove from other yard waste, place in black-lid waste cart
- **water softener products** – black-lid waste cart
- **wax** – black-lid waste cart
- **wax paper, soiled** – green organics cart
- **weeds** – green-lid organics cart
- **weeds, noxious** – black-lid waste cart
- **windows, broken** – wrap in newspaper, tape and place in black-lid waste cart or **request bulk pickup**
- **windows, in good condition** – **donate** – to organizations such as Habitat for Humanity Restore
- **window blinds (plastic)** – black-lid waste cart
- **window blinds (metal)** – see “scrap metal”

- **wine cork, plastic** – black-lid waste cart
- **wine cork (wood or cork)** – green-lid organics cart
- **wood pieces (treated lumber)** – black-lid waste cart or **request bulk pick up**.
- **wood preservatives** – bring to the CCRRA Annual Hazardous Waste Collection Event
- **wooden kabob skewers** – green-lid organics cart
- **wrapping paper (no foil)** – green-lid organics cart

X

- **Xylophones and other musical instruments** – **donate**; or black-lid waste cart or bulk pickup
- **Xmas & other holiday/party waste, when too much for bins** – place next to your trash bin, opposite any other containers, on collection day in a spare can or in a closed plastic bag.

Y

- **Yard and garden waste (large amounts)** – take to Glenn O Hawbaker Recycling Center
- **yarn** - black-lid waste cart
- **yogurt containers** - CCRRA miscellaneous plastic recycling container

Z

- **Ziploc bags or other storage bags (rinsed)** – deposit in local grocery store’s plastic bag recycling bin
- Ziploc bags (soiled) - black-lid waste cart
